- We can create harmony by performing multiple parts at once.

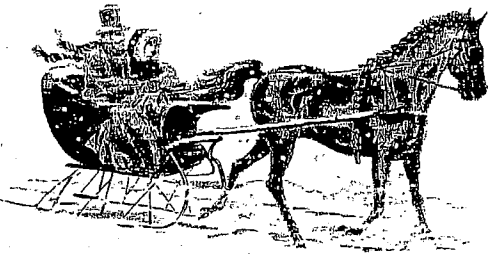
